About The Dropbox Tool

The **Dropbox** provides a convenient way for you to electronically submit individual and group assignments. Your instructor can then provide feedback, assign grades, and return submissions with track changes and comments.

To access the **Dropbox** tool from your Course Home page, click the **Dropbox** link on the course navigation bar located near the top of the screen.

- Links to any feedback that has been left by your instructor.

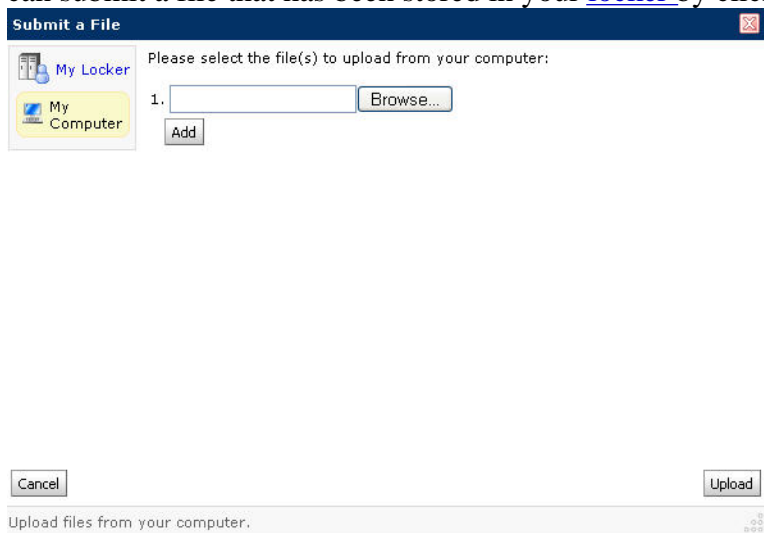

Submitting Assignments

You can use the **Dropbox** to submit assignments online by uploading files to designated folders. You can upload multiple files to a single **Dropbox** folder, but once a file has been submitted, it cannot be removed.

To submit assignments to the **Dropbox**:

- Click the folder name that corresponds to the assignment you are submitting the file for.
- You will be taken to a screen that confirms the folder's name and allows you to and type in any extra comments that you may wish to tell the instructor.
- Next, **Browse** for the file you wish to submit. You can browse your computer - this is the default option - or you can submit a file that has been stored in your [locker](#) by clicking [My Locker](#).




- If you would like to submit more than one file to the folder, click **Add**. This will add another **Browse** box for your use.
- Click . You will then be taken back to that specific Folder information page.
- You must click the SAVE button in the upper or lower right corner of the screen for your file to be submitted. In addition, you can upload more files by repeating steps 2 - 5, but remember to click Save when you are done.

Please Note: Do not include any symbols or special characters in the file names for the files you up load. Use only numbers and letters in file names.
